

GENERAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION:

- 1. Admission to LKG is generally announced in the SECOND WEEK OF JANUARY. FOUR YEARS as on 1st July is the age for admission in LKG. A corresponding scale of age is fixed for the subsequent classes.
- 2. A student joining the school for the first time must produce a satisfactory evidence of his/her date of birth certificate from the Municipal (Nagarpalika or Nagar Nigam). Date of Birth once recorded will not be changed.
- 4. When a student is admitted on a Transfer Certificate, he/she shall not be placed in any class higher than that for which the certificate shows him/her to be qualified, nor will he/she be promoted before the end of a school year.
- 5. A student who does not complete the school calendar year is not eligible for promotion; hence admission will be done accordingly.
- 6. No student will be admitted without a Transfer Certificate from the school last attended and in no case shall a student be permitted to attend a class pending formal admission.
- 7. Only students from recognised English Medium schools will be considered for admission.
- 8. The school leaving certificate of a student joining from a school outside Uttar Pradesh must be countersigned by the Educational Authorities of the District in which the previous school is situated.
- 11. In case of re-admission after withdrawal, admission fee will be levied again.

- 12. Preference would be given to SC/ST/OBC candidates and the marginalised.
- 13. The Principal reserves the right to admit or to refuse admission to anybody without assigning any reason for his action.

WITHDRAWAL:

- 1. Every application for a school leaving certificate shall be made in writing by the parents/guardian on the prescribed form.
- 2. A school leaving certificate will not be issued until all the fees are paid. Those who leave in April will pay the fees for May and June as well.
- 3. A fee of Rs. 200/- will be charged for a transfer certificate and this will be issued only three days after the receipt of an application.
- 4. The issue of T.C. implies that all dues to and from the school are completely cleared.
- 5. A student who wishes to discontinue during the academic session should pay the full fees of the particular quarter while applying for T.C.
- 6. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:
 - a) Disciplinary
 - b) Unsatisfactory Progress in Work
 - c) Detention or Repeated Detention in a class

GENERAL RULES

1. All students should be present in school on the opening day of each term.

- 2. Irregular attendance, unjustified absence or objectionable moral behaviour justify dismissal. If a student is absent for fifteen consecutive days without an application, or for three days at the beginning of a term, his/her name may be struck off the rolls.
- 3. Every absence has to be intimated to the Principal immediately with an application duly signed by the parents. No student who has been absent from school or is late will be admitted into class by the teacher without the signed permission of the Principal.
- 4. All students are expected to line up in silence for the Assembly at the sound of the first bell. Assembly is the most important part of the school day. Every student should be present at it to begin the day with prayer to God and to listen to the announcements and instructions of the Principal.
- 5. No books, other than the required text books, should be brought to school. No student should bring to the school any objectionable articles and electronic goods, such as camera, mobile, USB Pen Drive, iPad, iPod, tape-recorder, knives, weapons, crackers, explosives, etc. The offenders are liable to be dismissed or rusticated from the school and the confiscated goods will not be returned. The decision of the school authorities is binding on all.
- 6. No student should leave the school premises during class hours without the knowledge and permission of the Principal.
- 7. Any damage of school property will have to be made good. The decision of the Principal regarding the amount is final.
- 8. The school is not responsible for goods lost. Students should not carry or wear valuable articles including **rings and fancy watches** when coming to school. Students

- are liable to serious disciplinary action for stealing or damaging the articles of others.
- 9. No student suffering from a contagious or infectious disease will be permitted to attend school. After recovery a fitness medical certificate is to be submitted.
- 10. During school hours, students are not allowed to receive visitors or make phone calls or to answer a phone call. If the matter is very urgent, the message will be given.
- 11. No student should remain in the classroom during P.T. or Games period, unless permitted by the Principal.
- 12. Any student desiring to be exempted from P.T. or games must produce a doctor's certificate to the effect that he/she is physically unfit to take part.
- 13. All students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. They must come to school in school uniform everyday.
- 14. Students must come to class with the lessons well prepared and the home work completed.
- 15. The School Diary should be brought to the school daily.
- 16. Running, playing and shouting inside the school building is never allowed.
- 17. When students move along verandahs to other class rooms, they must walk in silence and in single line. They should always keep to the left as far as possible.
- 18. Students should be particularly careful not to throw papers or fruit peels anywhere in the school premises. They should use the bins especially provided for that purpose.
- 19. Students are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in school but also for their general behaviour outside. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct out of school shall make them liable

- to disciplinary action.
- 20. Students are not allowed to enter a classroom other than their own.
- 21. Articles found in school or on its premises are to be handed over to the office.
- 22. Parents send their children to this school so that they may be proficient in both in Hindi and English. **In the school premises all are expected to speak only in English**.
- 23. Students should at all cost avoid writing, scribbling carving and scratching on walls and furniture. Such habits are detrimental to good education and a sign of low taste.
- 24. Principal's permission is required:—
 - (a) to make a collection for any purpose whatever;
 - (b) to arrange for a party, picnic or meeting;
 - (c) to join a sports meet or to play a game not arranged by the school;
 - (d) to give presents to teachers or stage demonstrations in their honour; and
 - (e) to arrange for private tuition from the school teachers.

WE EXPECT YOU

- (a) To be polite, friendly and well-behaved in and outside the school.
- (b) To be honest and truthful, whatever may be the cost.
- (c) To accept cheerfully every work and responsibility given, and to face difficulties with courage and determination.
- (d) To be courteous and sportsman like on the playground with opposing teams and with the officials.
- (e) To wish your parents, teachers and elders whenever

- you meet them.
- (f) To respect your own property as well as of the school and also property belonging to others.
- (g) To be bold enough to say 'No' when asked to do a thing which you know to be wrong.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. The very first condition of admission is that parents/ guardians will comply strictly with the terms and conditions herein stated and pay by the due date the tuition fees and all other charges.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the parents to see that their wards reach the school and back home safely.
- 3. Parents are requested to enforce regularity and discipline. They will kindly see that their children daily prepare their lessons.
- 4. Politeness, courtesy of speech and conduct, cleanliness in dress and person should be inculcated.
- 5. Leave for absence may be granted for a sufficient reason, but only on an application from the parent or guardian. This should be made in advance whenever possible.
- 6. Any communication (request or complaint) made by a parent should be addressed to the Principal and not to the Class Teacher. When, thus communicating with the Principal, parents are requested to mention in their letter the name and the class with section of their child.
- 7. No visitors (parents or others) are allowed to see the students or interview their teachers during class hours.
- 8. Parents are also requested not to visit the classes during the class hours. All business will be transacted in the office.
- 9. Parents are requested not to call or take their children

- during class hours except in a case of emergency.
- 10. Parents and guardians are required to sign all the reports and to see that their children observe all the rules of the school.
- 11. Parents must realise that the parents-teachers meetings are very important and they should attend them regularly.
- 12. The Principal reserves the right to impose corrective punishment upon the students, as he may deem necessary.
- 13. Students must not keep much cash with them when they come to school. Such a habit is harmful. Please check them for this.
- 14. Small children should not be entrusted with payment of fees.
- 15. Students should not carry or wear valuable articles including **rings and fancy watches** when coming to school. **Fashionable hair style is not entertained**. Keep hair short and simple.
- 16. Only the children upto class V may wear casual dress on the day of their birthday. (A reasonable good dress like that of the school uniform).
- 17. We welcome constructive criticism, we feel happy when parents take interest in the welfare of the institution and give feedback for improvement.
- 18. Your child's school is required by law to maintain a safe, orderly learning environment. To do that, it has a school code with rules of behavior. The rules might include things like no obscene language, no hitting other children and no disrupting the class.
- 19. All students, including those with learning and attention issues, must follow school rules. If students break the rules, the school has the authority to discipline them. In fact, the

- school has a responsibility to do so.
- 20. The School is not responsible for the conveyance. It is the duty of the Parents to reach the child and take back after the school hours. The school does not provide any transport facility for students nor does it take responsibility for any external party providing transportation to the students. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their wards reach the school and return home safely. The school does not provide any parking facility in the school premises.

In the event of any irregularity arising from the transport services engaged by the parents, the school management shall have no obligation whatsoever for any eventuality.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- 1. Examination and tests enable parents to know the progress of their children and pay due attention to their studies at home.
- 2. There will be two examinations of the students to register their progress: Half Yearly and Annual.
- 3. Besides these terminal examinations, there will be four unit tests, which are compulsory. Any leave application on medical grounds during the examination period has to be submitted before or on the day of the examination. Any such application coming on a later date will not be accepted.
- 4. Promotion to the next class will be made on the basis of the average of the marks obtained in Half Yearly, Unit Tests and Annual Examination.

- 7. A student who, for reasons accepted by the Principal, is not able to appear for the Half-yearly, has to appear for the Annual and his/her result is based on this examination.
- 8. A student who does not appear for Half-yearly as well as Annual examination will not be promoted.
- 9. Students whose attendance is below 75% of the working days may not be eligible to appear for the Annual Examination.
- 10. A student who gives or obtains unfair assistance at an examination will be debarred for the rest of the examinations and will get a zero in that paper. Such a student may be detained in the same class or dismissed from the school.
- 11. A student who fails twice in the same class will be asked to leave the school.
- 12. Classes for class XI will begin in April. The admission and

- division of group will be based on a student's performance in Half Yearly, Unit Tests and Priliminary Examinations of class X as well as the conduct record of the student during the years in the school.
- 13. A student of class XI who does not achieve pass percentage in the total evaluation of the year will not be permitted to be regular student next year in the same class. However, he/she may be permitted to appear for the final examination at the end of that year at the discretion of the Principal. On passing in that examination, he/she may be admitted to the higher class (XII) as regular student once again, in which case his/her attendance of class XI will be accounted for.
- 14. Answer papers of Half yearly examinations are shown to the students. Answer papers of Annual Examinations are not shown. The result declared at the end of the year is final and not subject to reconsideration.
- 15. The school does not undertake to retain answer scripts Project works of students for more than 60 days after the results are declared.
- 16. A failed student forfeits all claims to concession in school fees.
- 17. The decision of the school authorities on results shall be final and in no case shall lie in any court of law in respect of their decision.
- 18. During the half yearly examination evaluation period the entire question paper will be solved by the students in their respective copies.

- 19. Passing in Moral Science is compulsory for promotion. 50% of the Moral Science marks are reserved with the Class teachers for behaviour and discipline of the student in the school. Rest, for the performance in the written examination.
- 20. All project works for classes IX to XII should be submitted before 10th of July. All defaulters will get zero in the subject.

LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Students should keep in mind that "Reading maketh a full man". They should develop the habit of reading books systematically and thoughtfully.
- 2. Silence should be maintained in the library except on business with the librarian. This also should be done in a low voice.
- 3. Students may borrow one book at a time for a period up to one week from the library. Any book not required by another person may be re-issued for a further week.
- 4. Certain books, magazines, etc. are available for reference in the library only. They are not to be taken home.
- 5. Books, periodicals, magazines, etc. should be treated with care, both in and out of the library. No writing, ink blots, torn pages, marks and lines in books, are tolerated.
- 6. Books are issued on the understanding that they are only to be read by persons to whom they are issued and are not given to others whether of school or to outsiders.
- 7. Any student who breaks the above rules will have to pay a fine or cost of the lost and damaged books.

LABORATORY RULES

- 1. Students must wear lab coat (white overall) in the laboratory.
- 2. Perfect silence in the laboratory is essential for concentration and successful scientific work.
- 3. Keep your table, apparatus and note-book neat and clean.
- 4. Add reagents in proportionate amounts, this gives the right result and key to success.
- 5. Keep the reagents in their respective places, do not change the stoppers of the bottles.
- 6. Avoid shifting the bottles from the common shelf.
- 7. Use the waste box for throwing broken glass pieces, match sticks, filter paper, etc. and do not throw them in the sink
- 8. Shake the test tubes while heating, do not throw hot and concentrated acids, specially conc. sulphuric acid.
- 9. Pass hydrogen sulphide gas slowly in the solution, it is a very poisonous gas, do not leave the gas stopper open.
- 10. Any damage to lab apparatus/equipments will have to be made good.

COMPUTER LAB RULES

- 1. Take off shoes before entering Computer Lab.
- 2. Wipe off feet on the doormat before entering the Computer Lab.
- 3. Bringing outside Floppy, C.D., Pen Drive is prohibited.
- 4. Unless and until needed, do not boot any system in the lab.

- 5. Don't move or shift the V.D.U. from its position.
- 6. Always insert the disk properly in the disk drive before closing its drive door.
- 7. Do not play with computer peripheral & wires.
- 8. Do not scribble on the machine casing, wires and tables.
- 9. Do not play with keyboard.
- 10. Always come with your group.
- 11. Do not bang the key, press them softly.
- 12. Always open and close the lab's door as instructed.
- 13. If anyone found misusing or playing with any computer peripherals he/she will be liable to pay a heavy penalty.
- 14. Computer Application/Computer Science is one of the subjects available for ICSE and ISC Level on merit/test basis respectively.

SCHOOL FEE

- 1. Fees are paid monthly. However, fees for the entire year or for the term may be paid together by cheque / draft or cash.
- 2. Fees should be paid before the date mentioned on the Fee Card, failing which a late fee of ₹50 will be charged for each month.
- 3. In case the Fee remains uncleared for three consecutive months, the student's name is liable to be struck off the rolls and if the Student wants to continue, Re-admission fee (₹5000/-) will be charged.

- 4. Fees of April, May and June must be paid before the school closes for the summer vacation.
- 5. No Student will be allowed to appear for the examination if all dues are not cleared.
- No exemption or reduction in fees will be made on account of any holiday, late admission, or absence for any cause.
- 7. School fees once paid will not be refunded in any case.
- 8. While applying for Transfer Certificate, Fee Card and Fee receipts should be produced.
- 9. For the loss of fee receipts duplicates will not be issued, instead a certifying certificate may be issued.
- 10. For the loss of the Fee Card ₹ 100/- will be charged.

TIPS FOR YOUR STUDY

Dear Students here are some tips for your study :

- 1. Start with a clean desk.
- 2. Sit up straight... a straight body... straight thinking...
- 3. Take up first, subject you most dislike. Once you have done this, the rest of your work will be easy.
- 4. Find out what is most important and study it first.
- 5. Do not hesitate to ask your teacher or your clever companions, things you cannot grasp clearly. Never omit any difficulty whatsoever, as this will put you in great difficulties later.
- 6. Never omit the lesson or homework.
- 7. Bring the books to the school according to the time table.
- 8. Always revise the work done in class and make sure that you have understood everything clearly and thoroughly.
- 9. If memorization is assigned, learn it overnight and repeat it in the morning.
- 10. Use your homework notebook to take down the work assigned for the next day. All homework should be done neatly and the day's work always dated. Revise at the end of the week.
- 11. Get enough exercise everyday. It keeps the mind fresh.
- 12. Lastly, pray often to the All-Wise and All-Knowing God to help you progress in your studies.

- * Responsible for his/her own property as well as that of the school and he/she respects the property belonging to others as well.
- * Bold enough to say 'No' when asked to do thing which he/she knows to be wrong.

Universal Solidarity Movement

The Five Paths of Universal Solidarity Movement:

- 1. Pray daily for Peace.
- 2. Skip a meal once a week.
- 3. Do a good deed a day.
- 4. Honour parents, teachers and all human beings.
- 5. Respect the earth and save its resources.

1. Pray daily for peace according to one's own religious tradition to be an agent of peace and reconciliation:

This appears very naive to intelligent adults. A ritual prayer said as a formula can be said very easily. Here we mean saying this prayer sincerely. This presupposes that the person cultivates an inner attitude of forgiveness and reconciliation *prior* to the prayer. Praying sincerely for the adversary creates an inner readiness to truly forgive and reconcile with him/her. Once the person has forgiven 'from the heart', then he/she can go further and sincerely pray for the welfare of the former adversary. A true prayer for peace will make one desire the welfare of all, especially those who have damaged one's reputation. The result is the experience of true peace within oneself. When individuals experience peace within themselves, they promote peace in their neighbourhood and in the country.

2. Skip a meal a week to express solidarity with the hungry and contribute the savings to those in need:

Fasting is not alien to us Indians. People of all religions practice this discipline as part of their religious requirements. But this module has a special purpose; it is meant to help us grow in sensitivity to the plight of millions of our brothers and sisters who are deprived of the necessities of life. The money thus saved can be used to alleviate the suffering of the disadvantaged.

In the case of students, missing meals is not required. What are important are the spirit and the attitude. So students are asked to sacrifice an ice-cream, a chocolate or a snack etc. and the money thus saved, can be collected and used to help the less privileged in a constructive way.

3. Do a Good Deed a day without any selfish motive, to develop loving concern for the nation :

Nation building is not just the responsibility of ministers and social workers. Every citizen, every student and child is a partner in building the nation by performing ordinary acts with a sense of responsibility.

Through this module teachers and students are made aware that they build up the nation when they save electricity and water, when one consciously helps a stranger in the street, gives a helping hand to an elderly person to cross the road or board a train, or picks up a piece of paper carelessly thrown on the school corridor or play ground and put it in the dust bin.

4. Honour Parents, Teachers and all Human Beings:

According to ancient Indian culture and tradition, parents and teachers are to be respected. They are considered God visible in our midst. In spite of the influence of a market culture, this good tradition is still alive. What is significant in this module is the expression, 'honouring all human beings.' Respecting parents and teachers is common. Even murderers and thieves do this. But we do not think of honouring the maid servant, who works in the house, the driver, the peon and all those of lower status in society. Do we honour them?

There is a clear difference between 'honour' and 'respect'. Respect may be a token gesture from social obligation or politeness. Honour comes from the heart as a result of genuine spirituality. Only a person who has discovered his own identity can honour others. Statusconscious and petty-minded people cannot honour others, especially the poor and weak. When we learn to honour all human beings, we will start accepting and appreciating the diversity, the 'otherness' in them.

5. Respect the earth and save its resources :

Earth is our Mother and she needs to be respected. This is expressed by saving her resources, like water, trees, etc.. One who respects her will not dirty her face by carelessly causing pollution. Unfortunately in our country environmental cleanliness is very much neglected. People may keep their homes clean, but will think nothing of dirtying public places. An example is the railway tracks. The garbage thrown out of train windows disfigures the landscape of our beautiful country. Never to throw waste out of train windows can be a discipline that can transform our environment. Through this module students and teachers are made sensitized to keep their environment clean as part of their self discipline.
